

Overview

Explore some of Nepal's most beautiful places with exciting adventure activity like trekking to Nagarkot- Dhulikhel for couple of days, Rafting, Bungee and Cannoning. This multi-activity package is designed around those of us that like to keep active whilst experiencing new cultures and exploring the quieter more untouched areas of your location. See Nepal from its adventure cities and towns and its Mountain, Rivers and villages. Discover its Mountain View, culture, white water River Rafting, Bungy.

On this trip (Nagarkot Dhulikhel Trekking) you will cultivate exotic feeling of being close in nature, villages or best described as rural Nepal and at the most Trekking in Nagarkot to Dhulikhel offers you awe inspiring majesty and beauty of dramatic mountain views. Your first destination is Chisapani where you will be enjoying the real boon of nature being away from the hubbub of city and your interaction with the local people will add another experience. Early sunrise view at Nagarkot is the most fascinating and mesmerising view. The village of Nagarkot is on the edge of the valley and offers superb views of the mountains as well as Kathmandu valley. Along with this you visit the temple at Changunarayan which offers you to have a peek observation of the religious practice of Nepali people. (Trek to Nagarkot, Trekking in Dhulikhel, Treks in Nagarkot to Dhulikhel).

Bungee Jump: Nepal's first bungee jumping site is situated 160m over the wild Bhoite Kosi River. It is located close to the Nepal-Tibet border, a three- hour bus ride from Kathmandu. As of now, there is only one agency offering this sport. The jump, at 160m, was designed by one of New Zealand's leading bungee consultants, and is operated by some of the most experienced jump masters in the business. It's mishap-proof. The agency takes safety very seriously. Has become amazingly popular. People come to do the must-do bungy jump, and fall in love with the area and want to explore more. A day's canyoning is the perfect companion to the instant adrenaline of the bungy.

Nepal's Hidden Canyons: Canyoning is an amazing full body and mind experience that enables you to explore some of the last forbidden places in the Himalayas. Cannoning is becoming part of a river, following its flow over natural obstacles. The Last Resort has a couple of the most beautiful canyons in the Himalaya – you can see that in the pictures! With wetsuits, harnesses and with the aid of ropes, your guides will help you navigate this breathtaking journey.

White Water Rafting: Tumbling from the snow-capped peaks of Tibet, the Bhoite Kosi river provides some of the most exciting rafting and kayaking in Nepal, and is quite possibly one of the best short river trips offered anywhere in the world.

Itinerary Details

Day 01 : Arrival In Kathmandu Airport (1345meters). Transfer to hotel- Hotel(D)

There you will be met by our Airport Representative and transferred to hotel by private tourist vehicle. Overnight at hotel.

Day 02 : Full day Sightseeing in Kathmandu Valley, 4 tour places covered today- Hotel(B/L/D)

The 4 tour places in Kathmandu are Patan durbar square, Pasupatinath temple, Swoyambunath stupa, boudhanath stupa, total 7-8 hours full day tour in Kathmandu, afternoon free to prepare for next day trek

Day 03 : Drive from Kathmandu To Sundarijal & Trek to Chisapani, total 6 hours- Lodge(B/L/D)

Drive from Kathmandu to Sundarijal which takes approximately one hour and trek from Sundarijal to Chisapani and it takes about four and half hours.

Day 04 : Trek from Chisapani To Nagarkot, 7/8 hours- Hotel(B/L/D)

Trek from Chisapani to Nagarkot which takes about six and half hours. Morning the northern mountain views attract you. You trek start to Chauki Bhanjag, which takes about 2 and half hours, you will stop here for an hour for your lunch. You continue the charming trails lead 3 hours toward Nagarkot. (Walking 5/6 hrs) Nagarkot, (2175m) is by far the most popular. In the clear weather the Himalaya range, stretching from Dhaulagiri in the west all the way past Everest to Kanchenjunga in the east, emerges from the darkness to greet the happy visitor with its awe inspiring majesty and beauty.

Day 05 : Trek from Nagarkot To Dhulikhel, 6-7 hours- Hotel(B/L/D)

As you approach Dhulikhel, a glut of cultural diversities, traditional practices, lush vegetation and rich birdlife unfolds before you. Dhulikhel (1440m.) is a small town of Newar with a long history. According to the records it has been around for more than 500 years. The artistic skill and urban ethos of its Newar inhabitants have created a place of charm and beauty. Streets are lined with bare-brick houses, carved wooden windows, sloping roofs, pagoda temples and sacred statues everywhere. The major places of worship here are the Narayan and Harisiddhi temples which are adorned with profuse wood carvings. The Gokhureswar Mahadev temple, a 30 minutes' walk to the eastern part of town, is a peaceful and scenic spot. The Bhagawati temple is situated at a height in the western part of Dhulikhel and dominates the skyline. From here, you can get a beautiful vista of the town and surrounding areas. Dhulikhel is set on a hill ridge and enveloped in copper soiled terraces with magnificent views of the central Himalayan peaks. Dhulikhel is well known for its sunrise views. It's a good way to get a glimpse of Nepalese village life. Overnight at Hotel, Dhulikhel

Day 06 : Drive Dhulikhel/Barabise. PM: Join 3-4 hours Bhotekhosi River Rafting, transfer to Last resort (B, L, D)

After breakfast, drive Dhulikhel/Barabise (The Last Resort). we stop at Dolalghat for Bhotekhosi River Rafting, it is about 3-4 hours of Rafting and then drive to Last resort.

Day 07 : Morning Bungy Jump & Canyoning PM: Drive Back To Kathmandu, transfer to hotel (B, L, D)

Free in resort, morning after breakfast, bungy jump & Canyoning afternoon walk around resort or just relax at resort, we drive back to Kathmandu in afternoon around 3 pm.

Day 08 : End of tour and Departure (B)

Free for leisure or last minute shopping until departure. Then, transfer to the international airport on time to connect your outbound flight.
