

Overview

Shivapuri hike day tour is one of most popular day hiking routes. The trail takes us up from Shivapuri National Park to Nagi Gumpa, a hilltop Buddhist monastery where panoramic views of the Kathmandu valley abound. Finish with a stop at a local bazaar in Sundarijal before heading back to Kathmandu. Shivapuri Nagarjun National Park is the ninth national park in Nepal and was established in 2002. It is located in the country's mid-hills on the northern fringe of the Kathmandu Valley and named after Shivapuri Peak of 2,732 m (8,963 ft) altitude. It covers an area of 159 km² (61 sq mi) in the districts of Kathmandu, Nuwakot and Sindhupalchowk, adjoining 23 Village Development Committees. In the west, the protected area extends to the Dhading District.

Highlights:

- Day trip from Kathmandu to two interesting religious sites
- Travel aboard a Private car to Budhanilkantha, the site of the sleeping Hindu god Vishnu
- Enjoy a moderate hike through Shivapuri National Park with your Local guide
- Follow a hidden path to Nagi Gumpa, a hilltop Buddhist monastery offering gorgeous views of the Kathmandu valley
- Visit a local bazaar in Sundarijal

Day 01 : 07:30 - Start hiking from south side of Shivapuri

Itinerary 06:30 AM - Breakfast at Hotel 07:00 - Pickup at Hotel, drive to Budhanilkantha (8kms, 25 minutes) 07:30 - Start hiking from south side of Shivapuri Hike to Nagi Gumpa, then towards to Sundarijal, Lunch en route 15:00 - Trek down to Sundarijal 17:00 - Drive back to Kathmandu
